

Confession and Forgiveness of Sin

The pastor invites the congregation into a time of confession, with silence for reflection. The pastor reminds the congregation of God's forgiveness, mercy, and peace for our hurting world.

P: Let us quiet our minds and open our hearts for confession:

A time of silence.

P: O God, we come before you to acknowledge that we have fallen short of your glory. We haven't loved you with our whole heart, we haven't loved our neighbors as we love ourselves. We have taken your beautiful creation and twisted it for our own selfish purposes. We ask for your forgiveness.

C: We've fallen short, God, forgive us.

P: In this time of silence we pour out our hearts to you, O God, knowing that you are slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. Hear us and forgive us.

A time of silence.

P: Hear the Good News. God doesn't treat us as our sins deserve, or pay us back in full for our wrongs. As high as heaven is over the earth, so strong is God's love to those who fear him. As far as sunrise is from sunset, God has separated us from our sins. Sisters and Brothers: your sins are forgiven, and you have life in the name of Jesus, be at peace.



P: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.



P: Lord, remember us in your kingdom, and teach us to pray:




